

GIVE JESUS' LOVE

JOHN 13:34-35

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

TO ONE ANOTHER “The measure of someone’s love is how much he is willing to give.” Hughes, John, p.126. (John 13:34, fn 13:34, John 15:9-17, fn 15:12, 13, Luke 7:47, fn 7:47, I Peter 1:22, 23, fn 1:22, I John 4:19-21, fn 4:19, fn 4:20, 21) *Why is loving one another vital in your relationships?*

AS HE LOVED US The measure of our Lord’s love is the cross. (John 13:34, fn 13:35, I John 3:16-20, fn 3:16, I John 4:7:12, fn 4:7, 4:8, 4:9, 10, Romans 5:5, fn 5:5, 6, fn 5:6, fn 5:8, fn 5:9, 10) *How is it possible for you to love the unlovely? What change of attitude do you need to make?*

SO THEY WILL KNOW we are Jesus’ disciples. Loving one another is our “badge” identifying us as His disciples. (John 13:35, fn 13:34, 35, II Cor 5:14, fn 5:13-15, Colossians 3:10-14, fn 3:13, fn 3:14, fn 3:14, 15, Matt 5:43-47, fn 5:43, 44) *Make a list of your enemies or people you dislike, and ask God to help you love them and for Jesus to be glorified in their lives.*

Check up—Are you praying with your spouse and your family? Group—Pray for personal requests and bond together by fellowshiping together.
