

WHAT'S YOUR POINT

ACTS 25:23-27 & 26:1-32

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

BACKGROUND: God's stage for Paul's witness had been set. You, like Paul, will have God-appointed opportunities to give your testimony for Christ. Are you aware of three vital points that will help you in leading someone to Christ? If not, I hope this will help.

ABOUT YOUR LIFE BEFORE—Paul grew up in a religious environment. Before he knew Christ, he was obsessed with “protecting” that environment by persecuting Christians. (Acts 26:4-11) *What phrase, sentence, word, or verse could be your first point in helping you tell about your life before Christ?*

ABOUT BEGINNING A RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST—Paul's personal relationship with the Lord began when he saw the light of Christ on the road to Damascus. (Acts 26:12-18) *What second point could help you remember the details about when you first trusted Christ as your Savior and your personal relationship with Him began?*

ABOUT YOUR LIFE NOW—Paul's desire was for all to experience a relationship with Christ. (Acts 26:19-29) Your life in Christ will be attractive to many unbelievers. *What third point is key for you to finish telling your new life's story? Suggestion: Practice telling your story to your family.*

The Bible was not written for our information only but for our transformation. *How will these verses change you in your walk with God and others? (Matthew 5:23, 24, I Peter 3:7)*
