

WHO ARE YOU LORD?

ACTS 9:1-9

How did you see God working in your life this week? (Romans 1:11, 12)

I AM THE POWER. Jesus got Saul's attention in a spectacular, humbling way. Blinded by our Lord, Saul had to depend on his companions to lead him by the hands. (**Acts 9:1-4, fn 9:2-5, Acts 22:1-8, fn 22:6ff, John 6:43-47, 60-65, fn 6:44, fn 6:63-65**) *How did the Lord get your attention in your spiritual journey and what were the results?*

I AM THE CHURCH, THE BELIEVERS, THE BODY, AND THOSE IN WHOM THE HOLY SPIRIT DWELLS. When Saul persecuted the saints, he persecuted Christ. (**Acts 9:4, 5, fn 9:5, Acts 26:9-15, fn 26:14, I Corinthians 6:14-20, fn 6:19, 20, I Corinthians 12:12-27, fn 12:13, Ephesians 4:11-16, fn 4:12, 13**) *As believers, could we be guilty of persecuting Christ? If so, how could this be avoided?*

I AM THE RESURRECTION. Saul saw Jesus as the one who died on the cross and was resurrected by God's power. Until we, like Saul, understand and accept by faith this fact of history, we cannot experience a personal relationship with Christ. (**Acts 9:5-9, fn 9:3-5, John 11:21-26, fn 11:25, 26, John 20:24-29, fn 20:29, I Corinthians 1:18, 19, fn 1:19, Ephesians 1:15-20, fn 1:19, 20**) *How does Christ's resurrection power enable you to live your Christian life?*
